Purpose

To provide participants with useful insights of the main issues of Corporate Governance and to illustrate how these issues affect several stakeholders (i.e. banks, small and medium organizations, Cypriot subsidiaries, family-managed organizations).

Who should attend

The seminar is addressed to all members of ICPAC, as well as other interested parties.

Speakers

Dr Marios Clerides. Marios obtained PhD in Economics from London School of Economics in 1982. Thereafter, Marios worked for many years (1982 up to 2001 and 2006 up to 2013) at different sections of Hellenic Bank. Specifically, during the period 2007 up to 2013 Marios was the Group Senior General Manager (effectively deputy CEO). During that period, Marios stopped Hellenic from over expanding in the Cypriot property market and investing into Greek Bonds. Marios headed the team that represented Hellenic Bank to Troika and the team that handled the sale of the bank's Greek operations to Piraeus Bank as part of the M.O.U. Prior to this post at Hellenic Bank, Marios was the Executive Chairman of the Cyprus Securities and Exchange Commission for 5 years (2001 up to 2006). In September 2014, Marios took the post of CEO of the newly created Coop Group, which had received state support from the Government of Cyprus. Marios dealt with Troika, DG competition, SSM, and the latest EU bank wide stress tests.

Mr Alexis Kyprianou. Alexis is an expert in corporate governance and negotiation, working on behalf of the national directors' institutes (i.e. in France, Belgium, Luxembourg, Morocco) to train directors in these countries on certification programmes and on-going professional development programmes for board directors. Alexis worked with numerous companies, particularly small & medium-sized companies. Prior to this, Alexis devoted a significant part of his 25 year career to mergers and acquisitions, working for Danone, Vivendi Universal and British Telecom. As part of his work, Alexis has negotiated corporate governance rights with partners and established the corporate governance structures in numerous companies. Alexis held a number of board directorships throughout his career, including a multi-billion revenue US energy company and Europe's largest cinema group. On the aforementioned boards, he served as the Chairman of the audit committee and as a member of a remuneration committee.
