EU Sanctions

New listings

1. Russia's war of aggression against Ukraine: Council sanctions 9 shadow fleet enablers

On 15.12.2025, the Council sanctioned additional five individuals and four entities responsible for supporting Russia's shadow fleet and its value chain, with a view to further curb Russia's revenue generating abilities.

2. Russian hybrid threats: Council sanctions twelve individuals and two entities over information manipulation and cyber attacks

On 15.12.2025, the Council decided to adopt restrictive measures against an additional twelve individuals and two entities, in light of Russia's continued hybrid activities, including Foreign Information Manipulation and Interference (FIMI) and malicious cyber activities against the EU and its member states and partners.

3. Haiti: Council lists three individuals and one entity over gang violence and related human rights abuses

On 15.12.2025, the Council adopted additional restrictive measures against three Haitian individuals as well as one entity in view of the escalating gang violence, unremitting serious human rights abuses committed by the gangs in the country, and the continuing impunity for the perpetrators.

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New Restrictive Measures

1. 19th package of sanctions against Russia: EU targets Russian energy, third-country banks and crypto providers

On 23.10.2025, the Council adopted a sweeping 19th package of further 69 individual listings and numerous economic restrictive measures targeting key sectors which fuel Russia's illegal invasion of Ukraine, including energy, finance and the military industrial complex. The Council is also strengthening control over the movement of Russian diplomats across the EU and taking further measures against those responsible for the abduction of Ukrainian children.

2. Democratic Republic of the Congo: Council prolongs individual sanctions by another year

On 8.12.2025, the Council today renewed its restrictive measures in view of the situation in the Democratic Republic of the Congo (DRC) by another year, until 12 December 2026.

UN Sanctions

1. Changes to the ISIL (Da'esh), Al-Qaida and associated individuals, groups, undertakings and entities 1267 Sanctions List and to the United Nations Security Council Consolidated List

On 16/10/2025, the Committee enacted amendments on its Sanctions List of individuals and entities subject to the assets freeze, travel ban and arms embargo set out in paragraph 1 of Security Council resolution 2734 (2024) and adopted under Chapter VII of the Charter of the United Nations.

2. Changes to the ISIL (Da'esh) and Al Qaida 1267 Sanctions List and to the United Nations Security Council Consolidated List

On 21/10/2025 the Committee enacted amendments on its Sanctions List of individuals and entities subject to the assets freeze, travel ban and arms embargo set out in paragraph 1 of Security Council resolution 2734 (2024) and adopted under Chapter VII of the Charter of the United Nations.



3. Changes to the ISIL (Da'esh), Al-Qaida 1267 Sanctions List and to the United Nations Security Council Consolidated List

On 6/11/2025 the Committee enacted amendments on its Sanctions List of individuals and entities subject to the assets freeze, travel ban and arms embargo set out in paragraph 1 of Security Council resolution 2734 (2024) and adopted under Chapter VII of the Charter of the United Nations.

4. Changes to the 1518 Iraq Sanctions List and to the United Nations Security Council Consolidated List

On 9/12/2025, the Security Council Committee established pursuant to resolution 1518 (2003) removed one entry from its Sanctions List of individuals and entities.
